## **Small Heath School and Sixth Form Centre GCSE and Equivalent Results 2011**

The results this year showed improvement in the percentage of pupils achieving five or more A\*-C grades and also five or more A\*-C grades including English and Maths. 62% of pupils attained five or more A\*-C grades this year with 53% achieving this standard including English and maths. We are extremely pleased that our pupils continue to demonstrate high standards of achievement in a quality, broad and balanced curriculum. 23% of our pupils gained five or more A\*-C grades which included English, Maths, Science, a modern foreign language and either History or Geography. We expect this figure to be well above the national average for pupils achieving what is being termed the "English Baccalaureate".

Once again, girls achieved higher standards than boys, 59% of our girls achieved five or more A\*-C grades including English and Maths.

Pupils with particularly noteworthy results were Qasim Wadood with 10.5 A\*-C grades including 8.5A\* and 3A's, Hafsa Ayaz with 10.5 A\*-C grades also including 7.5A\* and 3A's and Rehana Gul with 11 A\*-C grades including 7A\*'s and 4A's
